**RULEBOOK OF THE 10th REGIONAL JURIED EXHIBITION
„100 WOMEN - 100 MINIATURES“ – ARTISANS AND YOUTH FOR HERITAGE**

CALL FOR EXHIBITS

Call for exhibits in the 10th Regional Juried Exhibition “100 Women - 100 Miniatures” – Artisans and Youth for Heritage (hereinafter: Exhibition) is open from June 1 until September 30, 2023, welcoming exhibits by producers of handicrafts nationally and internationally, including crafters, art students, youth and artisans who agree to the terms of participation and provisions of the Rulebook.

Each exhibitor can compete with a maximum of three exhibits, in one or more exhibit categories and in response to themes determined by the Organizer. Only original pieces created in 2023, which the Expert Council evaluates as exhibits of high professional and aesthetic scope, are eligible for the exhibition.

EXHIBIT THEMES AND CATEGORIES

The theme of the Exhibition is “Traditional Heritage”. The aim is to stimulate participation of female artisans and young exhibitors (under 30 years of age) and secure preservation of traditional textile techniques. The motifs of exhibits should be related to the cultural heritage of Serbia and/or the country of exhibitor, including medieval ornamentation (frescoes and plastic of monasteries), ethnological material (textiles, pottery, wood, jewelry) or related to Cyrillic or Latin alphabet. Exhibitors are encouraged to supply representative, fine and innovative exhibits. Innovation can be achieved with bold coloristic combinatorics as well as by combining several techniques in one exhibit.

Exhibit categories:

1. weaving;
2. embroidery and gold-embroidery;
3. pottery and felting;
4. crocheting and filet lace-making;
5. combined*

* Works in combined category refer to application of two or more traditional techniques in a single exhibit, or an assemblage technique, or a collage of several different segments of handicrafts (using an antique piece as fabric or foundation for the exhibit, and including a description of the origin and story of the fabric in the identification form).

The prescribed size of the work is 10x10cm for exhibits that are two-dimensional, i.e. 10x10x10cm for those that are three-dimensional. For two-dimensional works in the technique of embroidery and gold embroidery, it is necessary to leave an additional 10cm of fabric around the embroidered motif to allow for framing.



APPLICATION PROCESS

Exhibits are submitted by completing the Identification form available on the websites www.1000zena.rs and www.etnomreza.rs.

By signing the Identification form, exhibitors agree to all provisions of the Rulebook.

The Identification form is to be supplied with each exhibit, legibly, in printed letters, with all the required data, to be used for the Exhibition catalog. Each exhibit comes with a label prescribed by the Organizer and included in the Identification form. Fee is waived for exhibits outside of Serbia.

Exhibits are delivered to the address: Etno mreža, Makedonska 30/VII, 11000 Belgrade, Serbia.

The organizer is not responsible for any damage due to transport.

All submitted exhibits are kept by the Organizer and are not returnable.

SELECTION AND JURYING

After receiving the exhibits, the selection process is carried out by the Artistic committee of the Organizer. The committee reserves the right to exclude exhibits that:

- deviate from the specified dimensions,
- fail to meet high professional and aesthetic scope,
- lack identification form and/or a label.

Notification of selection results will be available on the website www.1000zena.rs and www.etnomreza.rs and in social media.

The organizer will publish a catalog with exhibitors details and reproduction of all works selected for the exhibition. Each exhibitor receives a copy of the catalog free of charge.

After the selection, the Organizer will equip the selected works that will be displayed at the exhibition. Upon the opening, Expert Jury made up of ethnologists, institutional and corporate partners will select the works that will be awarded.

AWARD DELIVERY

The exhibition awards are: five equal awards for each exhibit category plus one award for young exhibitor (under 30 years of age). Each award equals the amount of 25,000.00 dinars (net).

Special award categories in 10th anniversary exhibition: regional and international award.

Awards do not have to be delivered in all exhibition categories. The jury can decide on other special awards and recognitions. In case of extraordinary circumstances, the exhibition will not be held. Additional information at info@etnomreza.rs
